The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

(a) Before the provider, director, their staff, household member, substitute or volunteer assume responsibility for the direct care of children, work in the facility or move into the Family Child Care Home or Family Child Care Center, the following shall be on file:

(iii) A child abuse/neglect Central Registry check which does not reveal any disqualifying information.

Explanation of Findings: It was found during an unannounced visit on December 10, 2020, that 3 employees in the facility are working without current Child Abuse and Neglect background check results complete and on file.

Action Required: Immediately (before the end of the day on December 10, 2020) submit the three missing central Child Abuse and Neglect background check forms for processing. Complete a variance to allow employees to continue working while these results are processed. Complete a Corrective Action Plan detailing how the facility will ensure that all staff members have current central registry on file in the facility prior to being allowed to work.
