The Department of Family Services has completed the investigation regarding alleged violation(s) of the Wyoming Child Care Rules received on 06/23/2021, and investigated by Michelle Tucker

A statement of childcare allegation, CPL-47482, was provided on 06/23/2021.

The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

1. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 4. General Requirements

Section 3. Provider, Director, and Staff Requirement

(a) Before the provider, director, their staff, household member, substitute or volunteer assume responsibility for the direct care of children, work in the facility or move into the Family Child Care Home or Family Child Care Center, the following shall be on file:

(iii) A child abuse/neglect Central Registry check which does not reveal any disqualifying information.

Explanation of Findings: It was found during a renewal visit on June 23, 2021, that there are three employees working in the facility without the required out of state central registry results or an approved variance. It was noted by licensing at this visit, that all staff requirements were met and that the facility has made huge progress with their staff records.

Action Required: Request a variance for the three employees by the end of the day today, June 23, 2021 and ensure that these out of state checks are submitted and being processed with the state office. Complete the corrective action plan detailing how the facility will ensure that all out of state central registries are requested and variances are on file, if needed, before allowing employees to work in the facility.
