A statement of childcare allegation, CPL-49886, was provided on 10/20/2022.

The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

1. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 4. General Requirements Section 3. Owner, Director, and Staff Requirements.

(a) Before the owner, director, their staff, household member, employee, substitute or volunteer assume responsibility for children, provide direct care of children, work in the facility or move into the Family Child Care Home or Family Child Care Center, the following shall be on file: (iv) Completed National Sex Offender Registry check and state Sex Offender Registry checks for Wyoming and for each state the person has lived in for the past five (5) years for staff, household members, substitutes, and volunteers. A person shall not be employed or present in the facility if the Sex Offender Registry check(s) states the person is a registered sex offender.

Explanation of Findings: No Fingerprint results are on file for a person who started working in the facility on 9/12/22.

Action Required: Submit Fingerprints immediately for the staff who has not yet been printed, and a variance request to be approved for the staff to return to work. Submit a Corrective action plan stating persons will not work in the facility prior to all background checks being on file or an approved variance to allow the person to be working on site.
