The Department of Family Services has completed the investigation regarding alleged violation(s) of the Wyoming Child Care Rules received on 12/22/2025, and investigated by Kathy Geringer.

A statement of childcare allegation, CPL-6041, was provided on 01/07/2026.

The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

1. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 4. General Requirements
Section 2. Capacity/Supervision Requirements.

(l) There shall be at least one (1) adult staff supervising the care of children at all times. Video and/or audio monitors shall not be used to fulfill staff supervision requirements.

Allegation: A report has been received that on or around 12/16/25, a 3 year old child was left on the playground after his teachers and class returned to their classroom.

Explanation of Findings: It has been found through investigation interviews that a 3 year old child was left unsupervised on the playground when his class returned the classroom on 12/16/25. The child was found to be missing when the class returned to their room. A staff immediatly returned to the playground to bring the child back to the classroom.

Action Required: Compliance and CAP were written by the facility and implemted prior to being received by Licensing on 2/11 & 2/23/26.

Administrative hearing procedures are included in the Department of Family Services' **Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules, Chapter 3, Section 5: Contested Case Hearing Rules**, and based upon the above statute.
