The Department of Family Services has completed the investigation regarding alleged violation(s) of the Wyoming Child Care Rules received on 03/10/2026, and investigated by Ariel Schmitzer.

A statement of childcare allegation, CPL-6077, was provided on 03/19/2026.

The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

1. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 8. Food Safety, Health and Sanitation
Section 3. Sanitation Requirements for Child Care Centers (CCC), Family Child Care Centers (FCCC), and Family Child Care Homes (FCCH).
(a) All Family Child Care Homes (FCCH), Family Child Care Centers (FCCC), and Child Care Centers (CCC) shall comply with the following standards:
(ix) Animals
(A) All animals, including animal equipment such as food dishes and bedding, shall be excluded from the food preparation, utensil, and equipment washing and dining areas.

Allegation: It has been reported that on 3/10/2026 there was animals in the facility and in the outdoor play space, and the facility did not have accurate and current vaccination records on file.

Explanation of Findings: It was found through evidence gathered that Vanessa's dog Ivy had an expired Rabies vaccination. Ivy now named Talla was vaccinated for rabies on 12/9/2024 and was required to receive a new vaccination on 12/9/2025 per vaccination records from the animal shelter.

Action Required: Immediately ensure that children do not have direct access to the dog until all vaccinations are up to date and current. Please submit a corrective action plan detailing how you will ensure that all animals in the facility and the children have access to the children are current on their vaccinations at all times.

2. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 4. General Requirements

Section 14. Health and Safety Requirements.

(c) The overall condition of the child care facility and grounds, including play areas, equipment, and toys, shall be maintained in a clean, uncluttered, safe condition and free of hazards.

Allegation: It has been reported that on 3/10/2026 the facility was not maintained in a clean and sanitary condition.

Explanation of Findings: It has been found by licensing during an inspection of the facility and outdoor space that the facility was cluttered in the living room, kitchen, and hallway. Large amounts of laundry was piled on the couch, plates with food on them and bottles with milk in them under some of the laundry. Emergency exit to the back play yard was cluttered and extension cords, laundry, and other supplies were accessible to children and blocking the path to the exit. Carpet cleaner solution was found on the floor in the kitchen area and chemicals were stored on the ledge in the bathroom where children could reach from the stepstool. The back play yard had a trampoline which had been damaged from the windstorm and can no longer be made inaccessible to children. Trash and broken play equipment was strewn through the lawn.

Action Required: Immediately begin decluttering areas of the home and outdoor area used for childcare purposes. Couch and surfaces need to be free of laundry, clutter, and dishes to prevent items falling onto child and to increase the supervision of all children in the facility. Cords and chemicals need to be up and out of reach of children. Pathway to back door needs to be clear and free of laundry and clutter to allow safe access to the door. Trampoline in the backyard needs to be removed or made inaccessible too children, trash, shoes, dog feces, and broken play equipment needs to be removed from the backyard. Please submit a corrective action plan detailing how you will ensure that the facility and outdoor space remains clean, free from clutter, and safe for children at all times.

Administrative hearing procedures are included in the Department of Family Services' **Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules, Chapter 3, Section 5: Contested Case Hearing Rules**, and based upon the above statute.
