The Department of Family Services has completed the investigation regarding alleged violation(s) of the Wyoming Child Care Rules received on 03/31/2025, and investigated by Teddie Schrayner.

A statement of childcare allegation, CPL-5902, was provided on 04/10/2025.

The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

1. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 5. Family Child Care Home (FCCH)
Section 2. Capacity/Supervision Requirements.

(b) There shall be at least one (1) adult staff supervising the care of children at all times and the following supervision requirements also apply:

(vi) Napping children who are not within sight of the staff person shall be within easy hearing distance at all times, be checked on every few minutes and meet all other requirements.

Allegation: Reporter alleges that in the month of March 2025 awake children were not directly supervised in the nap room, during nap time.

Explanation of Findings: It has been found that on multiple occasions in March of 2025, children in care were laid down in the nap room and left there without supervision. This lack of supervision occurred both when infants and toddlers who were awake were left alone without staff supervision in the nap room, as well as children only being checked on every 15 to 20 minutes, rather than every couple of minutes, once they were all asleep.

Action Required: Please submit a detailed corrective action plan showing how you will ensure that all awake infants and toddlers will be directly supervised at all times, including nap time. Also, please detail how children will be supervised once they are all sleeping.

If you disagree with the Department's finding of non-compliance for a violation, you may request an Administrative hearing within (10) days of your receipt of this letter (W.S. 14-4-108). Administrative hearing procedures are included in the Department of Family Services' **Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules, Chapter 3, Section 5: Contested Case Hearing Rules**, and based upon the above statute. If you have questions, or need a copy of the Rules, you may contact the Department of Family Services Field office in the county where you live.
