The Department of Family Services has completed the investigation regarding alleged violation(s) of the Wyoming Child Care Rules received on 05/19/2026, and investigated by Teddie Schrayner.

A statement of childcare allegation, CPL-6122, was provided on 06/02/2026.

The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

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1. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 11. HEALTH AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL FACILITY TYPES  
Section 19. Food Service and Nutrition.

(i) If parents choose to provide food for their own child, food shall be clearly marked with the child's name, refrigerated if needed, and consumed only by that child. If parents choose to provide food for their own child, food shall be clearly marked with the child's name, refrigerated if needed, and consumed only by that child.

Allegation: It has been reported that in the past 3 months, parents were provided unlabeled, and incorrect bottles at the end of the day giving the appearance that children were fed food and drink provided by other parents.

Explanation of Findings: Based on interviews and observations completed during this investigation, it was determined that the child care center does not routinely label bottles provided by parents that are kept in the facility's refrigerator, relying on staff recollection and identification for determination of ownership. It was determined that on at least one occasion in the past 3 months, food articles have been returned to an incorrect family, as items were not clearly labeled or marked.

Action Required: Please ensure that all children's individual meals, bottles, and cups are clearly labeled with their names to ensure each child receives the correct items. Additionally, please submit a corrective action plan to the Licensing Office detailing how you will ensure that all items remain easily identifiable in the future. This plan should outline the steps you will take to prevent children from receiving items belonging to others.
