The Department of Family Services has completed the investigation regarding alleged violation(s) of the Wyoming Child Care Rules received on 02/27/2026, and investigated by Teddie Schrayner.

A statement of childcare allegation, CPL-6076, was provided on 03/10/2026.

The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

1. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 4. General Requirements
Section 14. Health and Safety Requirements.

(c) The overall condition of the child care facility and grounds, including play areas, equipment, and toys, shall be maintained in a clean, uncluttered, safe condition and free of hazards.

Allegation: It has been reported that on one or more occasions in the last six months, there has been mouse feces in the facility which has been accessible to children, including on shelves where children's toys/books are stored, in children's toy buckets and/or on high chairs.

Explanation of Findings: Through interviews and evidence obtained over the course of this investigation, it has been found that in the last 6 months, there has been a mouse infestation at the facility that has not been properly controlled, resulting in mouse droppings being accessible to children, including on bookshelves, books, and highchairs in the kitchen area.

Action Required: The entire facility must be thoroughly cleaned and cleared of all, mouse droppings/urine, trash, debris, old food, and dirty dishes, then sanitized using increased bleach concentration by Monday, March 16, 2026. Immediately contact a pest control company to create a plan to control the current and mitigate any future mouse infestations. Submit a corrective action plan detailing the current measures being taken and include how the facility will ensure that cleaning and rodent control measures shall be implemented, in the future as needed. Additionally, please include how the director will ensure the facility is maintained in a clean, uncluttered, safe condition at all times. Licensing may conduct additional visits to monitor ongoing compliance.

If you disagree with the Department's finding of non-compliance for a violation, you may request an Administrative hearing within (10) days of your receipt of this letter (W.S. 14-4-108). Administrative hearing procedures are included in the Department of Family Services' **Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules, Chapter 3, Section 5: Contested Case Hearing Rules**, and based upon the above statute.
