The Department of Family Services has completed the investigation regarding alleged violation(s) of the Wyoming Child Care Rules received on 04/30/2026, and investigated by Ariel Schmitzer.

A statement of childcare allegation, CPL-6097, was provided on 05/06/2026.

The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

1. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 4. General Requirements
Section 2. Capacity/Supervision Requirements.

(I) There shall be at least one (1) adult staff supervising the care of children at all times. Video and/or audio monitors shall not be used to fulfill staff supervision requirements.

Allegation: It has been reported that on one or more occasions in the past three months a child in care has been dropped off at their elementary school prior to school district staff being present on the playground and the driver leaves the child unattended to wait for district staff to come onto the playground and unlock the gate.

Explanation of Findings: It has been found through interviews and evidence gathered that a child in care has been dropped off at their elementary school prior to the elementary school gates being open/unlocked and district staff present resulting in the child being left unsupervised multiple times.

Action Required: Immediately discontinue the practice of allowing drivers to leave children prior to district staff being present to accept children at the school. Immediately begin recording times on bus attendance sheets when the children get onto the busses and when they get off the busses. Please submit a corrective action plan detailing how you will train all staff who transport children the importance of ensuring children are always supervised and accurate attendance records are being kept.

The Department's information may be shared with the authorized individuals or agencies, which include, but are not limited to, the Attorney General, County Attorney, and law enforcement.

If you disagree with the Department's finding of non-compliance for a violation, you may request an Administrative hearing within (10) days of your receipt of this letter (W.S. 14-4-108). Administrative hearing procedures are included in the Department of Family Services' **Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules, Chapter 3, Section 5: Contested Case Hearing Rules**, and based upon the above statute. If you have questions, or need a copy of the Rules, you may contact the Department of Family Services Field office in the county where you live.
