The Department of Family Services has completed the investigation regarding alleged violation(s) of the Wyoming Child Care Rules received on 06/20/2025, and investigated by Ariel Schmitzer.

A statement of childcare allegation, CPL-5960, was provided on 06/30/2025.

The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

1. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 4. General Requirements
Section 11. Reports.

(a) All child care facilities shall report any injury, illness or incident which occurs at the facility and results in medical treatment, hospitalization or death to the parents of the child(ren) immediately and to the child care licenser within 24 hours. A written report shall be sent to the child care licenser within three (3) days of the incident. The death of any child in care, regardless of cause, shall be reported to licensing immediately.

Allegation: It has been reported that on one or more occasions in the last 4 months a child in care was injured while at the facility requiring medical treatment and staples and the director did not report the incident to licensing within 24 hrs.

Explanation of Findings: It has been found through evidence gathered and interviews with the director that on 4/15/2025 a child was injured in care requiring two staples, and taken to urgent care by his parent. This incident was not reported to licensing within 24 hrs by the director as required by State licensing rules and regulations.

Action Required: Facility will immediately begin to document all injuries and incidents and keep a copy of each report in the child's file. Facility will ensure that any injury or incident that requires a child to be seen by a doctor or a dentist is reported to licensing within 24 hours. Please submit a corrective action plan detailing how you will ensure that all injuries and incidents will be documented and documentation kept on file as well as how you will ensure that any injuries and incidents that require medical attention are reported to licensing within 24 hrs of the incident.

(iii) All known and/or treated injuries that occur to his/her child while he/she is in care;

Allegation: It has been reported that on one or more occasions in the past six month a child has been injured while in care and the parents were not notified of the incidents.

Explanation of Findings: It has been found through interviews with staff and the director that there is not enough evidence for a finding of non-compliance.

(x) Wet or soiled clothing, including disposable undergarments, shall be changed promptly. A sufficient supply of clean clothing shall be provided.

Allegation: It has been reported that on one or more occasions in the past six months children in care have been sent home in wet or soiled clothing and not promptly changed at the facility.

Explanation of Findings: It has been found through interviews with staff and the director that there is not enough evidence for a finding of non compliance.

(d) The following behavior shall be prohibited in all child care settings:

(iii) Inappropriate use of language, including but not limited to profanity, name-calling, derogatory or demeaning terminology or screaming related to disciplinary purposes;

Allegation: It has been reported that on one or more occasions in the past month staff member S.H. has yelled at the children in care including but not limited to phrases like "shut-up" or "better watch yourself or I'll put you in a glass box" at the children as a form of discipline.

Explanation of Findings: It has been found through interviews with staff and the director that there is not enough evidence for a finding of non compliance.

(d) The following behavior shall be prohibited in all child care settings:

(ii) Rough handling of children, including but not limited to hitting, spanking, beating, shaking, pinching, pushing or other measures that could produce physical pain;

Allegation: It has been reported that in the last month staff member S.H. has roughly handled children in care including but not limited to "slamming" child down in their chairs.

Explanation of Findings: It has been found through interviews with staff and the director that there is not enough evidence for a finding of non-compliance.

If you disagree with the Department's finding of non-compliance for a violation, you may request an Administrative hearing within (10) days of your receipt of this letter (W.S. 14-4-108). Administrative hearing procedures are included in the Department of Family Services' **Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules, Chapter 3, Section 5: Contested Case Hearing Rules**, and based upon the above statute.
