The Department of Family Services has completed the investigation regarding alleged violation(s) of the Wyoming Child Care Rules received on 11/04/2019, and investigated by Irene Maurer

A statement of childcare allegation, CPL-44562, was provided on 11/07/2019.

The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

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1. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 4. General Requirements  
Section 19. Infant and/or Toddler Care  
(b) Sleeping infants shall:  
(ii) Be placed on a firm, flat surface for sleeping;

Explanation of Findings: 8m. old sleeping in seating system (Ingenuity InReach Mobile Lounger & Bouncer - Quincy). Infant awoken, firm flat surface cleared for when infant falls asleep again.

Action Required: Please provide Corrective Action Plan detailing how facility and all staff will ensure sleeping infants will sleep on a firm flat surface as Child Care Licensing Rule requires.
