The Department of Family Services has completed the investigation regarding alleged violation(s) of the Wyoming Child Care Rules received on 10/27/2020, and investigated by Joshua Seilaff.

A statement of childcare allegation, CPL-5013, was provided on 10/30/2020.

The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

1. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 4. General Requirements
Section 3. Provider, Director, and Staff Requirement
(e) All staff, household members, substitutes, and volunteers shall complete a child abuse/neglect Central Registry background check once a year and a full fingerprint based national criminal history record background check every five (5) years.

Allegation: Reporter alleges that on or around the date of 10/27/2020 staff were working in the facility and providing direct care for children without having current central registry or sex offender registry completed and on file.

Explanation of Findings: A find of non-compliance is issued based on the most current CCL 205 staff/non staff summary on file, and after interviewing director about staff qualifications including central registry and sex offender registry.

Action Required: Please submit a corrective action plan to child care licensing stating how the facility will maintain current and updated staff qualifications at all times. As part of the compliance please submit a current and updated CCL 205 staff summary. Future monitoring visits may occur to ensure that the staff summary as well as staff qualifications including central registry and sex offender registry are current and on file at all times.

Administrative hearing procedures are included in the Department of Family Services' **Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules, Chapter 3, Section 5: Contested Case Hearing Rules**, and based upon the above statute. If you have questions, or need a copy of the Rules, you may contact the Department of Family Services Field office in the county where you live.
