The Department of Family Services has completed the investigation regarding alleged violation(s) of the Wyoming Child Care Rules received on 09/22/2020, and investigated by Michelle Tucker

A statement of childcare allegation, CPL-46129, was provided on 09/22/2020.

The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

1. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation: Chapter 4. General Requirements

Section 3. Provider, Director, and Staff Requirement

(a) Before the provider, director, their staff, household member, substitute or volunteer assume responsibility for the direct care of children, work in the facility or move into the Family Child Care Home or Family Child Care Center, the following shall be on file:

(iii) A child abuse/neglect Central Registry check which does not reveal any disqualifying information.

Explanation of Findings: It was found at a renewal visit on September 22, 2020, 6 staff member's central registries expired and were not re-run before the prior expiration date.

Action Required: New central registries have been submitted and variance request has been received. Ensure that staff with expired Central Registries will be supervised, with approved variance, by qualified staff members. Complete Corrective Action Plan detailing how the facility will maintain compliance with the requirement that all staff members have current Central Registry results on file at all times.

If you disagree with the Department's finding of a non-compliance violation, you may request an Administrative hearing within (10) days of your receipt of this letter (W.S. 14-4-108). Administrative hearing procedures are included in the Wyoming Department of Family Services Contested Case Hearing Rules, Chapter 2, Substitute Care and Child Care Licensing and based on the above statute. If you need a copy of the Rules, or assistance in requesting an Administrative hearing, you may contact the Department of Family Services Field Office in the county where you live.
