Explanation of Findings: A finding of non-compliance is based on observation by licenser on 11/25/19 at 10:45am. Licenser observed one infant in a bassinet and one infant in a playpen. Both infants had with them a blanket and toys while they were sleeping.

Action Required: At the time of visit, Rhonda removed the blankets and toys from the bassinet and playpen. Please send corrective action plan to licenser discussing how you will follow and maintain safe sleep practices with infants in your care.

Explanation of Findings: A finding of non-compliance is based on licenser's observation on 11/25/19 at 10:45am. Licenser observed one infant in a bassinet and one infant in a playpen. Each infant had a blanket piled beside and on their chest propping a bottle in the infant's mouth.

Action Required: At the time of visit, Rhonda removed the blankets and bottle from each infant's bassinet and playpen. Please submit a corrective action plan discussing how you will maintain compliance with safe sleep and safe feeding practices.
